Interim Guidelines for Members: COVID-19

Revised June 25, 2020

Swim Club Hours of Operation/Capacity- 1100AM-9PM, Monday-Sunday. NJ requires that we function at 50% capacity. In the event that the pool reaches our maximum capacity, we may have to temporarily prohibit additional members from entering. In the event that this occurs, we will communicate this as timely as possible so that members can plan accordingly. Based on the size of our membership, space at the club and prior pool utilization, we do not anticipate having to limit members' visits to the pool. We will be closely monitoring pool activities and will make adjustments as needed.

Check-In/Check-Out- As required by the State of NJ, we have separated the entrance and exit to the club. Members will enter the club through the clubhouse and exit via the gate by the playground. Members checking in at the club will be asked to answer screening questions for symptoms of and exposure to COVID-19. Members who answer "yes" to either of these screening questions are strictly prohibited from entering. Members who answer "no" to the screening questions are permitted to proceed to check in. Each member will check in, while masked and maintaining 6 feet from our staff member. Checking in will allow us to track the number of members in the club throughout the day. Each table at the club will be assigned a table number. When members exit the club, they will be asked their name and table number. This will assist in us dispatching pool staff to clean the table that the exiting member used. **Members should also wear a mask when checking out.**

Members' Responsibilities- It is critical that members stay home if they have symptoms of COVID-19, have tested positive for COVID-19, or were exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days. **Any member subject to State of NJ or a healthcare provider imposed quarantine may not use the club during the quarantine period.** Members are expected to wash their hands often and to use face coverings as feasible. Face coverings should not be worn in the water or by individuals 2 years of age or less. At a minimum, face coverings should be worn while checking in and out the club and while in line at the snack bar. Parents will need to remain diligent to ensure their children are following guidelines related to social distancing and hand hygiene. Tables have been placed in accordance with current guidelines and we would ask that members avoid moving tables closer together. While toys are permitted, we are discouraging the sharing of items that have not been disinfected between uses. Foot coverings are required when in the locker rooms, showers, and rest rooms. All members are required to sign the updated waiver prior to their first entry.

Enhanced Cleaning- Staff will conduct frequent cleaning of frequently touched surfaces including restrooms throughout the day and tables after each use. Tables will be numbered. When exiting the club, members should provide their table number so that turnover and cleaning can be tracked. In addition, we have increased our contracted janitorial services from 2X per week to 7X per week to ensure we are regularly deep cleaning our highest risk areas.



Guests- To maximize access for our members, guests are not permitted at this time. We will be closely monitoring the activity at the pool in next couple of weeks and can modify this if capacity permits in the future.

Staff- Staff will be screened upon arrival to the club including temperature checks.

Parties and Social Events (including Raft Night)- We are not permitting parties or other social events at this time.

Gaga Pit- Due to the inability to adequately social distance in this space, the gaga pit will remain closed until further notice.

Ping Pong- Members are encouraged to wash hands or use hand sanitizer prior to playing. Disinfectant will also be available and members are encouraged to wipe down paddles and ball before and after each use.

Basketball Courts- [The State of NJ Department of Health has placed basketball into the medium-risk category. Non-contact play is now permitted. Organized games/play remains prohibited at this time.](#)

Swim Team- Swim team began practicing on June 22nd.

Snack Bar- Not Just Snacks will be open. Members are required to wear masks when ordering or picking up given the limited ability to social distance during these transactions.
